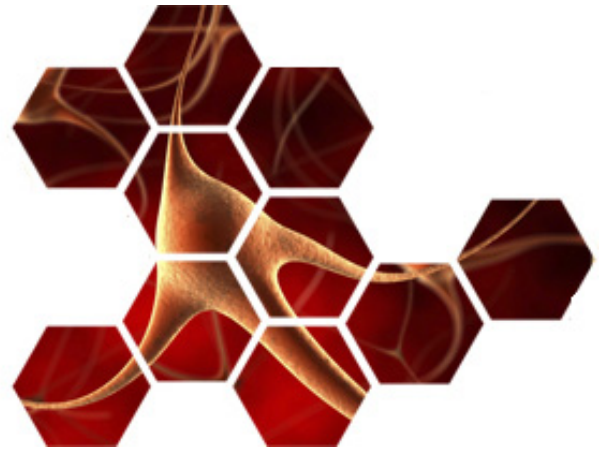

## EB 2011 TRAVEL AWARDS
